Minutes of November 28, 2017 Meeting**

Transportation Technical Advisory Committee Minutes of November 28, 2017 Meeting

- I. Call to order** – the meeting was called to order at 1:32 p.m. However, a quorum was not present.
- II. Approval of Minutes** – no action taken due to lack of quorum.
- III. Staff Update** – Ms. Schwenk presented the attendance record for 2017.
- IV. Unfinished business -**
- A. Revision of by-laws. No action due to lack of quorum.
 - B. Sidewalk Gap Study draft review. Mr. Morrison pointed out that the title should be changed to reflect that the study was actually an inventory and needs assessment. Sidewalk Gap came from the original work plan description that was changed. Mr. Morrison questioned whether \$1.2 million per mile for new sidewalk was accurate. Staff will re-check the numbers with VDOT.
 - C. FLAP Phase III Southern Tip Bike & Hike Trail Feasibility Study. Staff presented maps with potential routes from Capeville Drive north to the Cape Charles/Cheriton area. Members recommended that staff attend A-NTDC meeting on December 5 to get its input on the routes and to gauge whether another railroad crossing would be possible near the existing one east of the highway north of Dollar General in Cape Charles.
- V. New business -**
- A. Multi-Modal Plan. Staff presented maps showing where pedestrian and bicyclists are most often seen drawn from a meeting with Community Partners of the Eastern Shore and the previous meeting of the TTAC. Next these maps will be overlaid with crash statistics/locations, traffic signals, and STAR Transit stops.
 - 1. Members made recommendations to be added to the study:
 - a) Old Cape Charles Road from Route 13 to “The Hump.”
 - b) Add Bayview Circle Road at the intersection with Parsons Circle Road and Route 13
 - c) All of Route 182
 - d) Airport Road at Melfa
 - e) Whites Neck Road and Metompkin Road north of Fishers Corner.
 - f) Mappsville – whole section of Route 13
 - g) Remove Horntown Road – no one ever seen there.
 - h) Route 175 near Wattsville – Dreamland to Ray’s Shanty.
 - 2. Check on filtering accidents that involved speeding if possible.
 - B. Ditch Outfall update. Curt Smith reported that the A-NPDC has access to the latest most accurate Eastern Shore LiDAR data. The data still needs to be ground-truthed, and for this project, we need to identify ditch outfalls in order for VDOT to correct stormwater ponding issues and to map road elevations.
