Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome

The Accomack-Northampton Planning District Commission (A-NPDC) staff hosted a meeting of the Working Waterfront Steering Committee on Thursday, June 21st at 10:30am at the Hampton Roads PDC. Those in attendance included Beth Polak, Virginia Coastal Zone Management Program; John Bateman, Northern Neck PDC; Lewie Lawrence and Jackie Rickards (via Webinar), Middle Peninsula PDC; Ben McFarland, Hampton Roads PDC; Curt Smith and Shannon Alexander, A-NPDC.

2. Legislation Discussion

Relevant legislation was briefly discussed. Reference was made to the list included in the packet from the previous meeting of the Committee. Additionally, discussion about an overlay district for WWFs was discussed and Northumberland County draft ordinance concerning a Coastal Living Policy.

Since Lisa Hull was unable to attend this quarterly meeting, discussions concerning the idea of a Century WWF program akin to the [Century Farm and Century Forest programs](#) were tabled until the next meeting. However, Shannon Alexander did speak to Virginia DLS who expressed serious concerns about implementation and funding for managing such a program.

3. Comprehensive plan language and zoning options Fact Sheet

Shannon Alexander presented the draft four pages and various edits and additions were suggested, including language indicating 'why I should care' and more explanation for the TIF.

4. Coastal Living General Information Rack Card

The draft rack card, as completed by Full Circle designs, was reviewed and positively received. The A-NPDC is to have reference about the 2016 Virginia WWF Mast Plan added.

5. FY2018 Discussion

Two major ideas: RCVE Authority kick off meeting, working with legislators to develop a road map for the authority. NNPDC will lead the WWF outreach project, developing Story Maps and a professionally made promo video.

6. Next steps and next meeting

There will be one more meeting during the fall of the 2017 fiscal year.
