Staff informed the Committee on Consent Order, EAN TR21-1113 concerning the Town of Cape Charles Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Staff informed the Committee that residents of Captains Cove were reached out to by other residents with a notarized door-to-door survey as well as by Staff and Captains Cove management digitally with an electronic questionnaire. What are the implications for Virginia’s Eastern Shore’s residential and agricultural usages?

      4. Integration with other information (annual EM surveys and water level measurements)
      5. Specific steps to improve results or better understand the limitations

      8. Implementation within the existing SOW system or as separate systems
