Member Mastyl also reminded the committee about the reshowing of the PBS documentary, Against the Current, which will be airing on PBS on April 24, 2024, at 8:00 p.m. This can also be viewed on Youtube.

In old business, the GWC has reviewed the Groundwater Withdrawal Permit for the Town of Onancock. Staff attached a copy of the Comment on Draft Town of Onancock (GW0053901) Permit letter which will be sent to Eric Seavey at Virginia Department of Environmental Quality.

In new business, staff introduced Faith Lewis to the committee. Moving forward she will be drafting committee minutes and assisting Planning Staff with GWC website content and administrative tasks.

6. Residential Well Testing Program
Staff informed the GWC the RFP has been drafted. A-NPDC staff wanted to review the draft before releasing it. Member Walker has included definitions for quantitative and qualitative testing/analysis in the draft copy. Chairman Coker requested a schedule for the RFP and plan steps to follow.

7. Groundwater Outreach and Education

A sample of a trifold flyer was given to the committee. The committee discussed the flyer and requested it should include factual information with the # gallons a day for withdrawals and the depth should be mentioned. They also discussed the terminology, "dangers", referring to contamination from fertilizer should not be used.

Member Mastyl mentioned she was unable to attend the event Friday with the Virginia Organizing. The focus for this event was lower income locations with failing septic systems. Chairman Coker mentioned A-NPDC helps clients with failing septic systems. This is something maybe organizations could benefit from each of their work.

GWC will be partnering with Grace Holmes, from Virginia DEQ to handout flyers at the Earth Day event. Member Walker mentioned the opportunity to make a sheet regarding the public's concern or major issue they would like clarified or be informed.

8. April 16, 2024 Groundwater Consultant Report GWC Advisor McMillan referred to two permits submitted. KMC Camp due on 4/22/2024 and Seybolt Farms due on 5/6/2024. KMC is requesting the same amount as their current withdrawal. Seybolt Farms is requesting withdrawal amounts lower than their current permit. Discussion ensued. GWC Advisor spoke of the special conditions and withdrawal amounts. Graphics were shown on the screen to show the committee certain information. A copy of the presentation was attached to the GWC packet.
